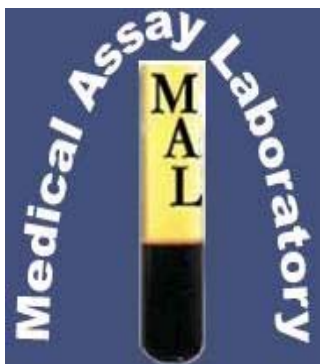

Admission

Admission Requirements:

1. Applicants for admission to MAPS must have either a high school diploma or a G.E.D (General Equivalency Diploma). Students who attended school outside of the U.S. must demonstrate that they possess high-school equivalency certificate.
2. All applicants must test negative for HBSAG (hepatitis), RPR (syphilis), and screened negative for drugs prior to being placed at clinical sites.



Tuition and Fees:

Tuition for the 4 or 5 weeks course is \$700
Books and supplies is \$150.

Space in the program is limited and a \$400 tuition deposit is required before the beginning of class to secure a position.

Schedule:

Medical Assay Phlebotomy School currently offers the following sessions:

5 weeks cohort 1, Saturday and Sunday from 10 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
Classes begin on March 27, 2010.

5 weeks cohort 2, Tuesday and Thursday from 6 p.m. to 8.30 p.m.
